Mesa Public Schools Junior High Athletics Baseball Rules 2010

- 1. Games will begin at 4:45 p.m. If both teams are present and warmed up, then begin at 4:30pm.
- 2. The game shall be six (6) <u>innings</u>. No new inning will begin after 90 minutes from the first pitch.
- 3. Each team will furnish 1 new game ball per game.
- 4. The rules shall be current edition of the National Federation Rules.
- 5. 90 ft. bases, 60' 6" pitching distances. No metal cleats or wooden bats may be used. There is no bat size or weight restriction.
- 6. Only eligible players and coaches in the dugout.
- 7. Nine (9) players allowed on the field at a time.
- 8. The number of coaches on base paths is limited to two (2). It could be a coach and an assistant coach. If a student athlete is occupying the coaching box, they must wear a batting helmet with ear protection.
- 9. The strict uniform rule does not have to be followed as long as team members can be identified as being a member of their team. Coaches do not have to be in uniform.
- 10. Jewelry may not be worn by student athletes.
- 11. By mutual consent of both coaches, a team may bat all of their eligible players and defensively substitute freely with the exception of the pitcher. The National Federation rules will apply to the substituting of the pitcher.
- 12. No Pitcher can pitch more than 8 innings per week.
- 13. A team may only score 5 runs per inning except for the sixth inning. Once a team has scored 5 runs in an inning, their time at-bat will end.
- 14. In the sixth inning, the amount of runs will not be limited.
- 15. A team leading by ten (10) runs after four (4) innings is declared the winner. This includes tournament play.
- 16. Optional Rule: At the agreement of both coaches, the batters will start with a 1-1 count.
