Co-Ed Soccer

- 1. A schedule among teams will be established.
- 2. The rules for soccer shall be the current edition of the National Federation of High School Rules for Soccer with the following exceptions:
- 3. Four -15 minute running quarters.
- 4. A five (5) minute water break will occur during each 15 minutes of play. A ten (10) minute break will occur at halftime.
- 5. Each team will be permitted one (1) time out per half. The time out will last one (1) minute.
- 6. The referee will stop the timer when a player is injured or when either team is not in an offensive scoring situation.
- 7. Only one official is required in regular season play. Two officials are required in tournament play. If two officials fail to arrive for a game, the game may be played with one official with mutual consent of both coaches. If no official is in attendance, the game will be postponed or canceled.
- 8. When an athlete or a coach receives a RED card in a game, he/she will not be eligible for the next game (whether it is a regular season or tournament game).
- 9. During tournament play <u>ONLY</u>, if the game ends in a tie, a shoot-out will take place. Each coach will select 5 kickers from their team to participate in the shoot-out. A coin will be tossed to determine who goes first. The team with the most goals from the shootout will be declared the winner.
- 10. The strict uniform rule does not need to be followed, as long as team members can be identified as being a member of their team.
- 11. Student athletes may not wear jewelry.
